CLASS XXVI

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the board had to make the determination not to hold a class for the 2020-2021 class year, and then again the decision was made not to hold the class for the 2021-2022 class year after the class roster was decided. The board received overwhelming support from our alumni and sponsors, and felt this was the right decision

as social distancing protocols would have eliminated the opportunity for class members to truly connect with each other, their session directors, and panelists.

Recruiting efforts for Class XXVI for the 2021-2022 program year began in the Spring of 2021, and the class was selected and notified. Unfortunately, just before the beginning of the class year, the decision was made to postpone the class due to ongoing challenges with meeting in person due to the pandemic.
